### 2. Character & Citizenship Education

For April, the 'Value of the Month' is **Respect**. Our foci are as follows:

### Habit 5 Seek First to Understand, Then to Be Understood:

- I listen to others without interrupting
- I listen to other people's ideas and feelings
- I see things from the viewpoint of others
- I listen with my ears, my eyes, and my heart

#### Habit 6 Synergize:

• I get along well with others, even people who are different from me

Respect means caring for the dignity of others in what one says or does. In line with that, students are taught social skills like using an appropriate voice level and listening. These skills are essential to Habit 5: Seek First to Understand, Then to Be Understood. In addition, FTGP lessons this month will also focus on empathy and resolving disagreements.

### 3. International Friendship Day – Friday, 5 April 2024

The commemoration of IFD allows our students to be sensitised to Singapore's geopolitical realities, and to reflect on the importance of

- an active foreign policy to maintain Singapore's international space
- openness to the international flow of trade, ideas and talent
- cross-cultural skills and a global orientation
- the spirit of friendship and collaboration amongst different people

The school will be commemorating International Friendship Day (IFD) on 5 April 2024. This year, the theme for IFD is **Singapore in Asia**. International cooperation remains key in our complex world. Asia is the world's fastest-growing region, and Singapore continues to facilitate closer economic, political, social, and cultural cooperation within ASEAN and in Asia.

By recognising the importance of connectedness between our neighbouring countries, our youth can play an active role in fostering people-to-people ties, and thus celebrate the region's diversity and vibrancy and promote the spirit of friendship and collaboration. In collaboration with the Parents Support Group, we have planned various activities during recess that day to help our students to be acquainted with the diverse and colourful culture and traditions of ASEAN and nurture in them the spirit of friendship and collaboration.

### 4. Hari Raya Puasa Celebration – Friday, 12 April 2024

This year, Hari Raya Puasa falls on Wednesday, 10 April 2024, our Muslim students will be dismissed at 10.30am on Tuesday, 9 April 2024, the eve of Hari Raya Puasa. All other students will be dismissed at the normal school dismissal time at 1.15pm for Primary 1 students and 1.30pm for Primary 2 to Primary 6 students.

Parents/guardians of Muslim students who wish to give consent for their child's/ward's early dismissal on the eve of Hari Raya Puasa are to submit their consent through a separate consent form issued through Parents Gateway.

Wednesday, 10 April 2024 is a school holiday and school will resume on Thursday, 11 April 2024.

The school will hold its Hari Raya Puasa Celebration on Friday, 12 April 2024. We would like to take this opportunity to wish all our Muslim students and their families Selamat Hari Raya Aidilfitri.

## 5. Earth Day – Monday, 22 April 2024

Many activities will be organized to mark World Water Day (22 March), Earth Day (22 April) and Biodiversity Week (17 May to 26 May). The purpose of these activities is to help our students understand the importance of everyone playing a part in protecting the environment.

### 6. Home-based Learning

Home-based Learning provides students with more opportunities to learn independently and to be more self-directed in their learning. Through home-based learning, students will become digitally-empowered 21st century learners who are collaborative and connected in using digital tools to co-construct and share knowledge with others.
