### **1. Early Dismissal on Selected Mondays in Semester 2**

- Monday, 13 October 2025 to Wednesday, 15 October 2025 (PSLE Marking Day)

- Monday, 10 November 2025 (Administrative Day)

## 2. Changes to School Uniform with effect from 2026

This to inform you about upcoming changes to our school uniform, which will take effect from January 2026. The changes include a refreshed school logo that will be featured on PE T-shirts, school shirts and blouses. For female students, the current skirt design will be replaced with a skort.

The new uniforms will be available for purchase from mid-November 2025. To ease the transition, a gradual phase-in period will allow parents ample time to make the switch.


